Teen Career Readiness

56 teen members earned a paycheck this summer while working and learning about Youth Development, Entrepreneurship, and the legal system.

More than 30 teens who received career readiness training were hired by outside organizations, including Lifespan, Waterfire, Old Navy, and other local businesses.



Summer Learning

This summer, BGCP partnered with Providence Public Schools again to run an 8 week Summer Learning Program (SLP) for over 100 kids. Members were taught literacy and math by certified teachers, preventing the typical summer slide.

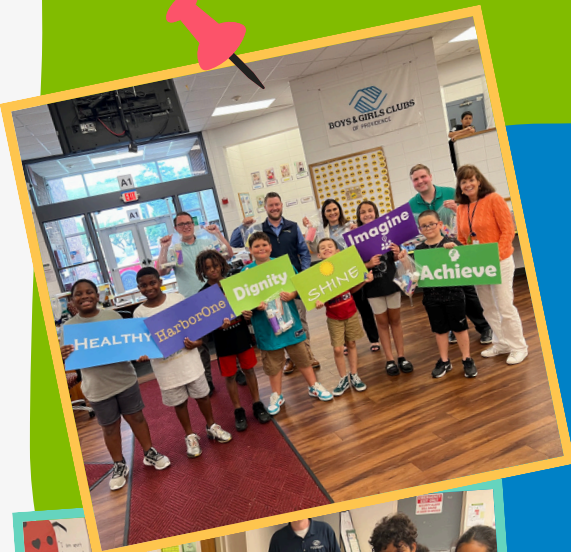
Over 410 youth came to our clubs every day
